Anatomy of a Fall - Winner of 2023 Palm d'Or


Director Justine Triet- Actors Sandra Huller as Sandra, Samuel Theis as Samuel and Milo Machado-Graner as Daniel.

You will be handed a boarding pass on entry to the exhibition with details of a passenger on that voyage. The only Exhibition in Australia to feature more than 200 real artefacts recovered directly from the wreck site. *The Exhibition* focuses on the voyage's compelling human stories, taking visitors on a memorable journey through the events of that fateful night.




